Purpose:

This policy was created to establish minimum requirements for Network Service Providers.

Scope:

This policy applies to all entities providing or managing core network services to any Health Science Center (HSC) Unit.

Reference(s):

Policy:

1. It is the responsibility of the Network Service Provider to provide network services that meet the security requirements specified in :
 - a. Federal and State regulations (see Policy GP0001);
 - b. University of Florida policies and standards (see Policy GP0001).
2. Network Services provided by external entities (contracted Network Service Providers) must be formalized via an executed contract and/or service level agreement that includes security requirements that meet or equal those referenced in Policy GP0001.
